



MIKE JORDAN TOUR 2025 REGULATIONS

We are pleased to announce the 2025 edition of the MMKMC Touring Assembly in the name of the late Mike Jordan. Our plan is to make a donation of any surplus funds arising on the event to Myeloma UK in his memory. In 2024 we were able to make a donation of £346 as a result of the generosity of our participants and venue owners.

1. ORGANISATION

- a. Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd will promote the **Mike Jordan Tour**, a Touring Assembly, on Saturday 28 June 2025. The event will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK, these Supplementary Regulations and any additional instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
- b. Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption number 203713 has been applied for.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- a. The event is open to four-wheeled vintage, classic and sports road cars, plus any other "interesting" modern cars at the organisers discretion. Please contact the entry secretary if you wish to discuss eligibility.
- b. All cars must hold a V5C Registration Document, current road fund licence, and have a valid MOT certificate or V112 Declaration of Exemption. Cars must not carry any competition numbers or display any advertising.
- c. Any person may enter the event.
- d. All drivers must be in possession of a valid driving licence for the car being driven. A competition licence is not required.

3. ENTRIES

- a. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close finally at 10 pm on Tuesday 24 June 2025. All entries must be made online at www.mikejordantour.co.uk to be followed by payment of the entry fee of **£85** if two people will be travelling in the car. Please add **£27.50** for each additional person to cover the cost of the refreshments provided.
- b. Final Instructions (including an Entry List and directions to the Start) will be emailed to participants during the week prior to the event.
- c. The entry fee includes one Roadbook, one rigid Rally Plate, an event souvenir, a bacon roll with tea or coffee at the start, lunch time refreshments and a one course meal at the finish. The entries secretary of the event, to whom all entry queries may be addressed is:

- d. The maximum number of cars on the event is forty. The minimum is twenty. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organiser's reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt as long as payment has been received.
- e. The running order will be decided by the organisers. If an entrant would like to run close to a friend/colleague, please advise the entry secretary by email chairman@mmkmc.co.uk
- f. Entries withdrawn before 10 pm on 24 June 2025 will have the entry fee returned in full. Entries withdrawn after this date may be the subject of a refund at the organisers discretion.

4. ROUTE

- a. The event will start and finish at the Pepperbox Inn, Windmill Hill, Harrietsham, Maidstone ME17 1LP.
- b. The route will cover approximately 100 miles
- c. The route will be given in an easy to follow Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event. The Road Book will also include a map on which the route will be shown.
- d. The first car will leave the start at 10 am.
- e. Along the route, there may be check points to observe the entrant's adherence to the defined route. These check points will be open for specified periods, giving adequate time to visit them while they are open.

5. START

It is recommended that cars and entrants arrive at the start at least 60 minutes before the start time to sign on then collect a pack with each entrant's Rally Plate and Road Book and enjoy the refreshments available.

6. IDENTIFICATION

Competitors will be identified by a Rally Plate, which will be supplied by the organisers. This must be displayed in a prominent forward facing position on the vehicle.

7. INSURANCE

All entrants must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event, and they will be required to sign a declaration to this effect as part of the pre event signing on process. The event has no competitive element.
