## SATURDAY 1<sup>st</sup> NOVEMBER 2025 REGULATIONS

**Maidstone and Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd** is continuing its series of Club *Tarmac* Autotests with the second event for 2025. The venue will again be **Ashford Livestock Market**, with a smooth concrete surface.

By popular demand, we are continuing with our two extra Classes as a **Production Car Autotest**:

**Class J** - for Juniors, with **free entry** for all Juniors. Funded from the prize money received by the club as Motorsport UK 'Club of the Year 2023'.

**Class P** - for those who want to have a passenger.

The Autotest event will be a round of the 2025 Southern Autotest Championship.

We are planning to run some new tests on the three test sites using the same layouts all day ........ so, only three tests to learn! As usual the tests will be more open and suitable for all cars, with flowing manoeuvres and all tests will include some reversing. All Classes will do the same tests.

## **SPRING 'TARMAC' AUTOTEST 25**

- 1. The **Maidstone and Mid Kent Motor Club Limited** will promote a **Clubmans** permit Autotest on **Saturday 1**<sup>st</sup> **November 2025** at **Ashford Livestock Market**, Ashford, Kent.
- 2. The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules of the **Motorsport UK** (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the Event.
- 3. The Event will be run under Dual Permits issued by **Motorsport UK**, which will be on display on the day. **Autotest Permit No.:- 204883**PCA Permit No.:- 204884
- 4. Both Events are open to entries from :
  - a) All fully elected members of the Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd;
  - b) Fully elected members of up to the first **15** other **Motorsport UK** recognised clubs received. Any such entry will be deemed acceptance of an invitation on behalf of that Club
- 5. The Autotest Event is a round of the 2025 Southern Autotest Championship.
- 6. All competitors must produce for inspection at signing-on a valid **Motorsport UK** Competition Licence and Club Membership Card. **This includes passengers in the PCA Classes**. (NCR 19.7.1.1)
  - (Note anyone who is disqualified from holding a RTA Driving Licence cannot hold a **Motorsport UK Competition Licence**).
- 7. Passengers are <u>not allowed</u> on any Timed Test for Classes A-F. (NCR 19.4.1.1)
  Passengers <u>must be carried</u> on all Timed Tests for Classes J and P. (NCR 19.5.2.1)
- 8. The programme of the meeting will be:
  - Scrutineering starts at **08.30** am
  - Any Competitors not signed on by **10.30 am** may be disqualified.
  - First car starts at 10.30 am.
- 9. The **Autotest** will consist of 5 classes as follows:
  - A. Touring Cars up to and including 12' overall length (including Minis with non-original front mounted engine and transmission layout driving the front wheels)
  - **B.** Front wheel drive Touring Cars over 12'
  - C. All rear wheel drive Touring Cars
  - **D.** Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars
  - E. Specials
  - **F.** Tarmac Autotest Experts with any vehicle specific for Tarmac Autotests. Classification for this class will be entirely the Organisers decision.
- 10. Entries will be accepted from drivers who are 16 years and over who do not have a valid, full RTA Licence (NCR 19.4.2.1) provided the vehicle they are entering is a touring car of no more than 1400cc, without forced induction, for the AUTOTEST.

- 11. The **PRODUCTION CAR AUTOTEST** will consist of 2 Classes as follows:
  - J. A PCA, for *Junior Drivers*. Aged 13 to 17 who do not hold a full RTA Licence. All vehicles competing in this class must be by definition "a Touring Car" not exceeding 2000cc including forced induction. Whilst competing, one passenger must be carried in each car, who holds a full RTA Licence, is a full member of an invited club, hold a valid Motorsport UK Competition Licence and be experienced in Autotests or Autosolos. (NCR 19.5.3.1)
  - P. A PCA, for any class of vehicle Whilst competing, one passenger must be carried and must be a member of an invited club and hold a valid Motorsport UK Competition Licence. (NCR 19.5.2.1)

In any Touring car or cabriolet/sports car with the hood erected the passenger must be aged 12 years or over and be at least 135cm in height (NCR 19.5.2.4), or with the hood down must be aged 16 years or over and at least 135cm in height (NCR 19.5.2.5).

Where the driver does not hold a full RTA Licence, the vehicle must be by definition "a **Touring Car**" of no more than 2000cc including forced induction and the passenger must hold a valid, full RTA Licence and be experienced in Autotests or Autosolos. (**NCR 19.5.3.1**)

**All passengers** must occupy the seat alongside the driver and wear a properly fastened and approved seat belt on any timed test.

#### Note

Cabriolet Saloon Cars must run in appropriate Touring Car class with the hood up, or in the appropriate Sports Car class with the hood down (where applicable).

Vehicle length is to be determined from Parkers Car Price Guide for the car concerned, or if not quoted, the manufacturers specification.

All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations. (NCR 7.2)

12. Awards will be presented as follows:

FTD An Award (Classes A-E only)
Best Performance by a full An Award (Classes A-E only)

member of the Maidstone &

Mid Kent Motor Club

First in Class An Award

Second in Class An Award (subject to 5 or more starters)
Third in Class An Award (subject to 10 or more starters)

Best Novice An Award (Classes A-E only)

No competitor may win more than one award.

13. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes finally on **TUESDAY 28<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2025 at 10.00pm**. The entry fees are :

AT 20 OCTOBER 2023 at 10.00pm. The end

£35.00. for Classes A-F and P.

Free Entry for Class J.

All entries must be made on the official entry form and must be **accompanied by the appropriate fee.**

14. Entry fees will only be refunded if notice of withdrawal is given in writing. Where notice of withdrawal is received before 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025 entry fees will be refunded in full, after that date refunds, up to a maximum of £25, will be made at the discretion of the organisers (NCR 6.1.11.1).

## LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

- 15. The **Entries Secretary** is **Ann Cook** (**tel: 07740 248868**) who will deal with all enquiries regarding entries.
- 16. The maximum entry for the meeting is **40**. The minimum is **20**. The maximum for each class is unlimited. The minimum for each class is 1. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected as received.
- 17. Other officials are:

- 18. Provisional results will be published, and awards presented, as soon as possible following the end of the event.
- 19. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with the Motorsport UK Protests. (NCR 2.9.1)
- 20. Details of tests will be included with Final Instructions. (NCR 19.1.1.4)
  Each driver will have up to Five runs at each test, with their worst time at each test discounted for awards. (NCR 19.1.1.4b and 1.4i)

Timing will be via **STOPASTRIDE LIVE TIMING** and mobile phones operated by the start marshals

The starting signal will be oral.

Order of attempting the tests will be strictly as directed at the drivers briefing.

- 21. All marshals will be appointed as judges to adjudicate on penalties. (NCR 19 1.4.1).
- 22. Practising will **NOT** be allowed **(NCR 19.1.2.4)**, any competitor, in the opinion of the organisers, speeding, or performing handbrake turns or the like, in the paddock or surrounding area may be **disqualified**.
- 23. Competitors will be identified by numbers; which will be issued at signing on. **(NCR 19.1.1.4c)**
- 24. Marking and penalties will be as printed in Penalty Table (NCR 19.9).:
  - (a) "Not performing a test correctly, etc" +20 seconds
  - (b) "Striking any marker, etc per mistake" + 5 seconds
  - (c) "Failing to cross or stop at any line, etc" + 5 seconds

A Wrong Test will be as defined in (NCR 19.1.3.1).

- 25. A Novice will be defined as a driver who has not previously won a class or overall award in an Autotest or similar competition of **Clubman**, equivalent or higher status.
- 26. Pylons may be less than 1 metre in height (NCR 19.1.2.7).

- 27. As the whole event takes place on private property vehicles need not be Registered or Taxed (NCR 19.3.1.2.)
- 28. Hybrid and Electric Vehicles, and Light Goods Vehicles are not permitted. (NCR 19.3.1.4)
- 29. A vehicle may be entered twice, for each event, but in all cases must be driven by different drivers. (NCR 19.1.1.4k).
- 30. All other General Regulations of **the Motorsport UK** apply as written.
- 31. Please make sure your Vehicle is in good mechanical condition. In particular, please make sure that your vehicle complies with **Motorsport UK** Vehicle Regulations specific for Autotests (**NCR 19.3.1.8**). Also please ensure your engine is properly silenced and complies with the noise requirements of (**NCR 7.8.2**) and note tyre regulations (**NCR 7.2.13**).
- 32. In accordance with latest General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) the information you give us will be used only for the purpose of running MMKMC events and its activities. You will only receive communications from us that are relevant to the events you enter. Photographs may be taken at this event (and others in the programme) and shared, including on social media. Please advise the organiser if you do not wish to have your photograph taken.
